This is an attempt to combine a kind of Middle-Eastern scale with an Irish tune structure. It might sound a little weird until you get used to it, after which it will continue to sound weird but maybe you won't mind it as much. (Note to backup players: the chords are there for guidance only - if you come up with better ones, go with them!)
