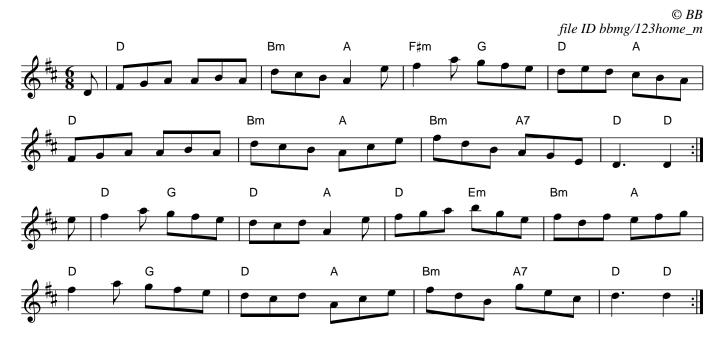
Home to Mullach
